Ordered That Capt. George Keports deliver to Capt Alex Lawson Smith of the Maryland Part of the Regiment late Rawlings' 3rd Regt (Colt 3rd & 4th Battalions) of the first Quality in part of the Articles allowed by the Gen^l Assembly.

That the said Capt Keports deliver to Ensigns David Green and Robert Green of the first Brigade 3rd Regt (Colt 3rd & 4th Battalions) of the third Quality each in part of the Articles allowed by the General Assembly.

That the Collector of the Tax for Harford County pay to Capt Alex Lawson Smith of the late Rawlings' Regiment three thousand Dollars to be expended in the Recruiting Service and Accounted for.

That the Collector of the Tax for Baltimore County pay to John McClellan Richard Lemmon and Isaac Grist Commissioners for Baltimore Town five thousand Pounds to enable them to carry into Execution the Act for the immediate supply of Flour and other Provisions for the Army to be accounted for.

That the Collector of the Tax for Montgomery County pay to Ensign David Green of the 7th Regiment one thousand eight hundred Dollars to be expended in the recruiting Service.

Jonathan Hudson Esq^r is requested to deliver 300 pieces of Britishies purchased of him by this Board to Capt George Keports or in his absence to Mr William Bankes.

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt Alexander Lawson Smith of the late Rawlings' Regiment 3rd Regt 1st Linen for Lining and 2 pair of Stockings in part of the Articles allowed by the General Assembly.

That the said Commissary of Stores deliver to David Green and Robert Green of the first Brigade 3rd Regt 1st Linen for Lining and 2 pair of Stockings each, in part of the Articles of the 2^d.

That the said Commissary of Stores deliver to Patrick Murphy, Charles Thompson, William Snow, Pharoah Elmer, James Bayless, Robert Gutton, James Wood, John Lawrence, James Weldon, William Joyce, Andrew Marwood, William Johnston & Philip Jains, Recruits for the 4th Regiment - Leonard Hagan, John Neighbour & William Thompson Recruits for the 7th Regiment, each, 1 Coat, 1 Waistcoat, 1st Breeches, 1st Overall, 1 Shirt, 1 Hat, 1st Shoes and one pair of Stockings the Bounty allowed them by the late Act of Assembly, and also to Thomas Keef of the 7th Regiment 1 pair of Shoes.

That the said Commissary of Stores deliver to Serj John Smith of the 2^d Regiment 1st sufficient for 1 Jacket and pair of Breeches.

That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Serj John Lindiff five thousand Dollars to be by him expended in the Recruiting Service & Accounted for.

That the said Treasurer pay to James Hanna one hundred Pounds allowed to him by this Board from the 16th August 1779 to the Instant by virtue of a Resolve of the General Assembly passed the 7 of August 1779.
