By a certificate transmitted to this Board by James Shaw one of the Justices  
of the Peace of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland, it appears that Freeborn Ganetson  
was carried before him as a Disaffected Fugitive from the State of Delaware, who on Examination  
by him acknowledged he had not taken the Oath of Fidelity to his State or either of the United  
States and also refused to take the Oath prescribed by an Act of the General Assembly of  
Maryland entitled an Act for the better security of the Government, whereupon he committed  
him to the Goal of Dorchester County. Ordered that the said Freeborn Ganetson be released  
from his Confinement on his entering into a Bond in the Penalty of £20000 with good and  
sufficient security for his personal Appearance before the Executive Council of the State of  
Delaware within 20 Days from the Date of the Bond and also to return a certificate from the  
said Executive Council of his having made his personal Appearance before them within 30  
Days from the Date of the said Bond.

Leave is hereby given if his Excellency General Washington shall approve  
the same to William Potts Esq. to bring from New York by the same Conveyance in which  
Mrs. Schuch Chamier Furniture is brought, a Mahogany Bedstead, Feather Bed and  
suit of Curtains, he having satisfied this Board that they are his property & not intended for Sale
