Permission is hereby given to Mr Alexander of this State to solicit leave from his Excellency General Washington or the Commanding Officer at the out Posts of the American Army at Elizabeth Town to go into the City of New York not to return again into this State during the present War between America and Great Britain without the leave of the Governor and Council for the Time being first had and obtained.
