That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Starwood Esq<sup>r</sup> Com<sup>r</sup> Treas<sup>r</sup> on Order one hundred and Eight thousand four hundred and seventy four and two third Dollars as part of the four & Million six hundred and Eighty thousand Dollars appropriated to the use of Congress by the General Assembly of this State, the balance left unpaid of an Order of the 10<sup>th</sup> July last on the Coll<sup>o</sup> of the Tax for Kent County which was returned to this Board and Lodged with the Continental Treasurer
