Doct^r Gustavus Brown is recommended by this Board to His Excellency General Washington
or the Commanding Officer at Elizabeth Town for his Licence to go into the City of New York for
the Purpose of obtaining a passage to Great Britam, and under the peculiar Circumstances of his
Case to return again to this State agreeably to a Resolved of the House of Delegates of this date.

On the application of William Smith Esq^r of Baltimore Town who is to
this purpose commissioned and authorized by W. Holker who is Agent for the Marine
of His most Christian Majesty, Licence is hereby granted to load and export in the Schooner
Holker and a Home now lying in the Port of Baltimore, three cargoes of Flour and other Provisions
for the use of the Fleet and Army of His most Christian Majesty in the West Indies, the
said Schooner clearing out at the proper Office and the Captains complying with the Act of Asy
in such Case made and provided.

for the 1st Regiment one Suit of Cloaths the Bounty allowed by the late Act
