That the said Treasurer pay to Sir John Lindiff two thousand Dollars to be by him expended in the Recruiting Service and accounted for

That the said Treasurer pay to Richard Keene a Com^d for Caroline County one thousand Pounds to enable him to carry into Execution the Act for the immediate Supply of Flour and other provisions for the Army on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to William Sands forty six Pounds due him for Account paid by the Depy. Aud.

That the Eastern shore Treasurer pay to Nathaniel Potter one thousand Dollars to enable him to carry into Execution the Act for the immediate Supply of Flour &c.

It appearing from a Certificate of the President of the State of Delaware of the 20th of March last Deposited with this Board, that Freedom Garnetson who hath given Bond for his Personal appearance before the Executive Council of the said State of Delaware, that the Tenor of the said Bond is complied with, It is therefore Ordered that the same be cancelled.

On the Application of William Smith Esq^r of Baltimore Town who is to this purpose commissioned and authorized by a W^m Holker who is Agent for the Affairs of His most Christian Majesty Licence is hereby granted to Land and Export in the Schooner Baltimore now lying in the port of Baltimore, her Cargo of Flour and other Provisions for the use of the Fleet and Army of His most Christian Majesty in the West Indies, the said Schooner clearing out at the proper Office and the Captain complying with the Act of Assembly in such Case made and Provided.
