That the western shore Treasurer pay to Joseph Wilton jr^o one hundred and thirty seven eleven shillings and three Pence due him of A^cl. paid by the Aud. Gen^l. ~

That the said Treasurer pay to Lt. Samuel Farmer Eight thousand Pounds to be delivered over to George Keports to be applied in the purchase of Cloathing for the Army & also the further Sum of Twelve thousand, six hundred Pounds to be delivered to the said Geo Keports to be expended in the Purchase of Blanketts on Account ~

That the said Treasurer pay to Enf John Lowe of the 2^d Regim^t. four hundred and fifty Dollars the Borty paid Hampton Courney enlisted by him and one hundred Dollars the allowance for enlisting the said Courney. ~
