Commissions of Letter of Marque and Reprisal issued to Charles Harrison Comm^r of the Schooner Advice 38 Tons burthen navigated by 14 Men mounting 4 Carrage Guns, 4 Swivels and 6 Muskets also to William Howard Commander of the Schooner Folger, 50 Tons burthen navigated by 17 Men mounting 6 Howitz and 4 Swivels and belonging to Matthew Ridley and Compy of Baltimore.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Col^o Uriah Forrest ninety one Pounds, two shillings and six pence and seventy three Pounds, Eleven shillings and three Pence for the use of Col^o Francis Ware. One hundred and two Pounds ten shillings for the use of Tho^s Crankalls and Twenty nine Pounds six shillings for the use of Francis Dixon per Accounts passed by the Aud. General.
