Commission of Letters of Marque and Revival issued to William Ward Command of the Schooner Laurens, 50 Tons Burthen, navigated with 10 Men minding & Sailing Time belonging to John & Edward and Thomas Yeates of Baltimore.

Ordered That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Majr John Anderson the Lieut Henry Dalton of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> each 1 piece of Brittannies - to Majr Alexander Brouncker of the 7<sup>th</sup> Reg<sup>t</sup> and Capt Walker & Hujo of the 1<sup>st</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> each Trimmings for a Coat and one piece of Brittannies - to Capt Edmund Compton of the 1<sup>st</sup> Reg<sup>t</sup> Trimmings for a Coat 1 piece of Brittannies and 1 pair Stockings - to Lieut Patrick Donnelly of the 7<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> Cloth for a Jacket and Breeches, Trimmings for a Suit of Cloaths 1 piece of Brittannies and 2 pair Stockings - to Lieut Peter Harcastle of the 7<sup>th</sup> Regiment Trimmings for a coat, 1 piece Brittannies and 2 pair Stockings - to Col Thomas Woolford of the 5<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> Trimmings for a suit of cloaths, 1 piece Brittannies and two pair Stockings - to Capt Jonathan Sellman of the 4<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> Trimmings for a suit of Cloaths & 1 pair Brittannies - to Lieut Edward Dwall of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Reg<sup>t</sup> Cloth sufficient for a suit of Cloaths with Trimmings & 1 piece of Brittannies - to the Reverend Mr Montgomery Chaplain to the 1<sup>st</sup> Brigade of Maryland Troops 1 pair of Brittannies part of the Articles allowed by the Genl Assembly & also to Capt John Smith of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> 2 Coats, 29 Waistcoats, 7 pair Coats, & 2 pair Stockings in the Account of said Reg<sup>t</sup> as a bounty allowed by the Act of Assembly, 31 Blankets to be charged to said Regim<sup>t</sup> also 2 Coats, 2 vests, 1 pair of Coats, 2 Hats and 2 pair of Shoes to be delivered over to the Recruits of the 4<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> as a bounty allowed by the Act of Assembly and 12 Blankets to be charged to the said Regiment - and also to Lieut Augustus Baguof 7 piece of Brittannies one of which to be retained by himself the other six to be delivered one to each of Capt Lieut Findley, Lieut Robert Wilmet, Young Wilkinson, Isaac Rawlins, Clement Thrett and John Chever of the Artillery Companies in the Cont<sup>l</sup> Service - to Capt Richard Dancy 1 pair of Brittannies for Lieut James Wfaddon of Artillery part of the Articles allowed by the general Assembly - to Jacob Owens a private of the late Capt Gains Comp<sup>y</sup> 1 shirt, 1 pair Coats and 1 pair Shoes - to Capt Henry Gaithe 30 Blankets for the 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Reg<sup>t</sup> also 10 Blankets for the 5<sup>th</sup> & 24 do for the 7<sup>th</sup> Regiment.

Ordered That John Shaw Armorer Deliver to Col Forests Order Water Cart for a Transport taking Troops to Virginia to be charged to the Contment - also 20 lb of a Musket powder for the use of the Transports going to Virginia with Troops to be charged to the Contment at £15 - -

That Capt George Keports deliver to Capt Lieut Eben Findley, Lieut James Wfaddon, Augustus Baguof, Young Wilkinson, Robert Wilmet, Isaac Rawlins, Clement Thrett & John Chever of the Artillery Comp<sup>y</sup> Trimmings suff<sup>t</sup> for a suit of Cloaths.
