Ordered That the western shew Treasurer pay to Henry Ridgely three hundred and eighty three pounds, sixteen shillings and eight pence due him of ac. paper by the D. Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Wilmetts Three hundred and eighty three pounds six shillings due him of ac. paper by the Depy Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Eshman Two thousand Dollars to be deliv^d. due to Eugene Tylough Lieut of the 3^d Regim^t of Light Dragoons & Baylons: value of the same allowed by Act of Assembly

Ordered That the said Randall Esq^r Governor of the State of Maryland purchase in the Indies the best sugar coffee and bay Rum which come Broad Cloth and Trimmings in the use of the Officers and privates of the Maryland Troops in the Continental Service

Whereas it appears to this Board from a certificate from George Keports, that he came home in August 17th enlisted James Fox as a private to serve for three years in the Company etc then commanded in the German Regiment, but not being a German or the Son of a German could not serve in that Regiment and, at his own request was turned over to a Company of Foot in Baltimore Town and it also appearing from a Certificate given by Nathaniel Smith who commanded the said Company to which he was turned over that to his knowledge he never signed any Enlistment with him, the said James Fox having served the time for which he engaged is hereby Discharged

Ordered That the western shew Treasurer pay to Richard Daltam Esquire Ten thousand pounds and also the further sum of Ten thousand pounds on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt John Smith one hundred and sixty eight pounds seven shillings and six pence due him of ac. paper by the D. Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to his Excellency Thomas Sm Lee Esquire one thousand pounds in part of his Salary due the 1st May

That the Eastern shew Treasurer pay to Richard Daltam Esquire Twenty thousand pounds on Account

That the Company of Shoes deliver to Capt John Smith of the 6th Regim^t 6 coats, 6 waistcoats, 6 pair of Breeches, 6 shirts, 6 pair of Shoes, 6 pair of Overalls, 6 pair Stockings and 6 hats the Bounty allowed by the Gov^t & Assembly and to be accounted for and 6 Blankets to be charged to said Regim^t to be delivered over to so many Recruits of same Regim^t

That the said Company deliver to Nicholas Hutchinson, John Brooks, John Dawson, John Murphy, John Cokeran, Peter Duthouse and Esq^r Daniel Recruits for Recruits in the 7th Regim^t each 1 pair Overalls and to John Riggie a Recruit for the same Regim^t 1 pair Shoes and 1 pair Overalls in part of the Bounties allowed them by the Act of Assembly for raising the Quota of Troops &c and the Supplement thereto - also to Capt William Beatty of the 7th Regim^t 1 Blanket to be charged to the said Regiment
