In virtue of an Act of the General Assembly of this State entitled "An Act to prohibit, for a limited time the exportation of Wheat, Flour, Rye, & Indian Corn" Permission is hereby given to Capt Thomas Smith to transport from this State to the Islands of Bermuda three hundred Bushels of Indian Corn in the Sloop Hope for the Relief of the Inhabitants of the said Islands, Provided the said Captain Thomas Smith, his Officers, Passengers and Crew previous to his Landing on board of the said Vessel any Corn, shall take the Oath prescribed by the 17<sup>th</sup> Section of the Act above mentioned.

Ordered That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt Henry Gaither 1 Camp Kettle 1 Bucket 4 Seamers & Marlines for the use of the Hospital in this City and also to John Pierce Samuel Pierce, John Denoon Recruits for the 6<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup>. and to Thos. Whitaw a Recruit for the 1<sup>st</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup>. each a Suit of Cloaths the Bounty allowed by the late Acts of Assembly.

That the said Commissary deliver to John Mandle of the 6<sup>th</sup> Regiment one Blanket to be charged to the said Regiment.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Col<sup>l</sup> Mueh Bonest Eleven hundred Dollars the Bounties paid two Recruits John Murphy and Joshua Atkins for entry there.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt John Lynch one hundred and seventy nine Pounds, ten shillings due him of Acc<sup>t</sup> passed by the Depy Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Allen Dwyer one thousand, one hundred and Eighty eight Pounds, five shillings and the further sum of four hundred and nineteen Pounds fifteen shillings due him per Acc<sup>t</sup>s passed by the Depy Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to William Goldsmith, Six hundred and ninety six Pounds due him per Acc<sup>t</sup> passed by the Depy Aud.

That Mr. Jivall deliver to Mr. Muir 2 Hides to pack up Medicines belonging to the Courtment and to be charged to the Courtment.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to David Willoughby a Cont<sup>l</sup> Soldier in the Delaware Regim<sup>t</sup>. with the small pox 1 shirt, 2 Shirts, one Blanket and a Mahaf to be ch<sup>d</sup> to the Courtment and also to John Quinine of the 7<sup>th</sup> Maryland Regim<sup>t</sup> a Blanket ch<sup>d</sup> to said Regim<sup>t</sup>.
