

Friday 26th May 1780

Present as on yesterday.

Ordered That the western shew Treasurer pay to Ensign Caleb Mason of the 2^d Regim^t twenty four Pounds, twelve shillings and six Pence due him per Ac^t passed by the De^l Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Randall four hundred and thirty six Pounds ten shillings and also the further sum of ninety six Pounds, fifteen shillings for the use of Lieut Edward Dyer of the 2^d Regim^t per Ac^t passed by the De^l Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Doct^r Thomas Pagan one hundred and seventy Pounds due him per Ac^t passed by the De^l Aud.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt Berry of the State Boat the Plate 20th 24th of Trowsers, 1 Linen Jacket and pair of shoes to be delivered over to negro Michael the Property of the State.

The State Boat Plates took in State Goods for the Troops in Virginia and to act as a Convey to Maj^r Lees Partizan Rangers on their way thro' one half to be ch^d to Cont.

Proclamation issued for calling a meeting of the General Assembly of this State on Wednesday the 7th Day of June next.

Ordered That the western shew Treasurer pay to Lieut Edward Duvall eighty eight Pounds ten shillings per Ac^t passed by the De^l Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Ensign Samuel Hamilton of the 6th Regim^t five hundred and fifty six Pounds due him per Ac^t passed by the De^l Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Charles Bican twenty five Pounds per Ac^t passed by the De^l Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Jonathan Parker three hundred Pounds on Ac^t.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Robert Berry four hundred and twenty one Pounds ten shillings due him per Ac^t passed by the De^l Aud.

That the Commissary deliver to Capt Fisher 20th Candles for the use of Maj^r Lees (who now on their way to the Southward to be charged to the Continent)

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Ensign Jacob Crawford of the 2^d Regim^t 13 Blankets 2 of them for Recruits of the 1st 2 for the 2^d 2 for the 4th 2 for the 5th & 5 for the 7th Regim^t to be charged to the several Regim^{ts}.

Permission is hereby given to William Bacon to solicit Leave of Gen^l Washington as the Commanding Officer at Elizabeth Town to go to New York for the Purpose of obtaining a Passage to Great Britain agreeably to a Resolve of the House of Delegates of the 10th of April last.

Monday 29th May 1780Present as on Saturday except D^r Canoll Reg^t.

Ordered That the western shew Treasurer pay to Tho^s Boone one hundred and ninety one Pounds six shillings for paying & taking care of David Willoughby a sol^d of the De^l Reg^t in the small pay to be charged to the Continent.
