Permission is hereby given to Capt Daniel Padden to Transport from this State to the Islands of Bermuda nine hundred Bushels of Indian Corn on the Sloop Francis for the Relief of the Inhabitants of the said Islands.

Wednesday 31st May 1780

In virtue of an Act of the General Assembly "entitled an Act to empower the Governor and the Council to sell the Public property therein mentioned" Commodore Thomas Graven is hereby discharged from the Service of this State.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Com^o Thomas Grason one hundred and forty eight Pounds, three shillings and six Pence for the use of the men lately in the Service of this State as per pay roll examined and passed by the Depy Aud.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Daniel Boyle of the 2^d Regim^t 1 Coat, 1 Vest 1st Pair of Breeches, and 1st Pair of Stockings due to him for 1780 to be charged to the State.

The Sec^y & M^r David Love is Recommended by this Board to his Excellency Gen^l Washington or the Commanding Officer at Elizabeth Town for his License to go into the City of New York for the purpose of Obtaining a passage to Great Britain. The said M^r Love is not to return to this State during the Continuance of the Present War between America and Great Britain, without the Leave of the Governor and Council for the Time being first had and obtained.

Thursday 1st June 1780.

Ordered That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Lieut Woolford of the 2^d Reg^t 6 Suits of Cloaths and 6 Blankets for 6 Recruits enlisted by him, the Bounties allowed by the General Assembly.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Daniel Boyle late a Soldier in the 2^d Regim^t Twenty Pounds, the gratuity allowed by the Gen^l Assembly for the Year 1779

Friday 2 June 1780

Present as on yesterday.

Ordered That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Philip Howard of the 5th Reg^t and to Robert Price of the 7th Regim^t each 1st Pair of Overalls, 1 Shirt and 1st Pair of Shoes and also to William Pennell of the 2^d Regim^t 1st Pair of Overalls and 1 Shirt to be ch^d. to the Reg^ts

That the said Commissary deliver to John Rivers of the 1st Regim^t 1 Shirt, 1st Pair of Overalls & 1st Pair of Shoes, — to Henry Stanidge of 2^d Regim^t 1st Pair of Shoes, — to John Hanson a Recruit for the 6th Regim^t one Suit of Cloaths the Bounties all^d. by the Gen^l Assembly — to Lieut Geo Jacob of 6th Regim^t 3 yds Dowlas for lining & 2nd Pair of Stockings & to Capt Horatio Flagott 1st Pair of Breeches of the Article all^d. by the Gen^l Assembly.
