That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt Richard Davis of the late Rawlings's Regiment, a Suit of Cloaths the Allowance by the late Act of Assy

That the Collector of the Tax for Talbot County pay to Thomas Skimmer appointed by this Board a Recruiting Officer for said County, three thousand Dollars to be by him expended in the Recruiting Service and Accounted for

Commissions of Letters of Marque and Reprisal issued to William Thomas Commander of the Schooner Freeman 70 Tons burthen navigated by 14 Men mounting 6 small Guns belonging to Archibald Patson M^o of Maryland - to Clement Warring Commander of the Brig Duke of Lenster 70 Tons burthen, navigated by 14 Men, mounting 4 Carrage Guns, belonging to Charles Crookshanks and Company Maryland, and also to Joseph Charibault Commander of the Brig Pogue 90 Tons burthen navigated by 20 Men mounting 4 Carrage Guns belonging to Sam^l Smith M^o of Baltimore.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Gustavus Homer of this State Surgeons Mate in the Hospital Department one hundred and Fifty Pounds the Gratuity allowed by the Resolution of the General Assembly of Decem^r 11. 1778 and also Two thousand Dollars in lieu of Arrears allowed by the Act relating to the Officers and Soldiers of this in the American Army &c^a passed July 1779 and agreeably to a Resolution of the Gen^l Assembly of June 17th 1780

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Jenifer Esq^r to be Delivered over to Daniel Jenifer of this State, Surgeon in the Hospital Department, one hundred and Fifty Pounds the Gratuity and also two thousand Dollars, allowed him according to the above mentioned Resolutions and Act of the General Assembly

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Edward Prall of the 1st Regiment Two thousand Two hundred and Fifty Dollars to be expended in the Recruiting Service & Accounted for

That the issuing Commissary deliver to John Davidson 3 Hides and 3 Tunes or to Hides if there are no Tunes.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Gustavus Homer of this State in the Hospital Department, 3/4 yds Cloth, 3/4 yds Linnen for Lining, 3/4 yds Shalloon with Trimmings & Linnen for 2 Straps agreeably to a Resolue of 17 June 1780. - and to Capt Edw^d Prall of 1st Reg^t 1/2^d British in the Article &c^a
