Present as on Yesterday.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson jr Thirty five Pounds for so much Money advanced by him to Nicholas Yancy for the purpose of defraying his Expenses to Virginia on an Express.

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Hollingsworth Six thousand five hundred and forty six Pounds for 20472 lb Bohea Tea bought of him by Mr John Randall State Agent & for which he gave an Order dated 17th May 1780.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Duckett Two hundred and seventy four Pounds, three shillings Bal^t of Account passed by the Depy Aud.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Marshall Galloway of the 3^d Regim^t 1 Shirt & Mr Simon Conally to be charged to said Regiment.
