William Fitzhugh Esquire appointed Recruiting Officer for Calvert County.

Ordered That the western shew Treasurer pay to John H. Stone Esq. Five hundred Pounds in part of his Salary.

That the said Treasurer pay to William Shaw one thousand one hundred & eighty six Pounds for Damages done his House.
