

Monday 26th June 1780

Present as on Saturday.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Francis Rawlings for forty Pounds due him of Account passed by the Depy Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Isaac M^r Hard Three hundred and Thirty Pounds due him of Ac^t. passed by the Depy Aud.

Tuesday 27th June 1780

Present as on Yesterday.

Ordered That Mr John Shaw deliver to Capt^l William Middleton & Robert Berry of the State Boats Dolphin & Plater each 15^{lb} Cannon Powder.

That Mr John Shaw deliver to the said Capt^l W^m Middleton 13 Stands small Arms, 40 rounds of Cartridges to each Stand, 6 Cullaspes, 19^{lb} Gunpowder Paper and 3 p^r Pistols and also to Capt Robert Berry for the Plater 12 Stands small Arms 40 rounds Cartridges to each Stand, 12 Cullaspes, 6 Pickers, and 6 p^r Pistols - and also to Samuel Shaw 5^{lb} & 5 fathoms of Match rope to be used as paid for.

Commission of Letters of Marque and Reprisal issued to John Stewart Commander of the Schooner Molly 60 Tons Gunther, navigated with 13 Men mounting 4 Carriage Guns belonging to Smith Johnson Esq of Baltimore and John Stewart of Annapolis and also to James Buchanan Commander of the Brig Fox 80 Tons Gunther, navigated with 22 Men mounting 9 Carriage Guns belonging to John Doney Esq Baltimore.

In virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly of this date the Continental Treasurer is requested to exchange the sum of Fourteen thousand Dollars in Cont^l Bills of Credit for the like sum of Continental Loan Office Certificates to be lodged in the Treasury, the Money to be delivered to Stephen West Esq for the Accommodation and convenience of His Excellency Governor Rutledge.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt Robert Berry Three hundred Pounds to be by him Accounted for.

Wednesday 28th June 1780

Present as on Yesterday.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to William Middleton three hundred Pounds on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Jonathan Parker one hundred and fifty Pounds on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Robert Daxhull Two hundred & forty Dollars the Freight of 9 Bbls of Pork from Somerset County to the City for the use of the State.

That the said Treasurer pay to His Excellency Thomas Sim Lee Six thousand five hundred Pounds in part of his Salary to the 31st of May last.

That the Armonie deliver to Jos^{ph} James Toolall 5 p^r Sweeps, 15^{lb} Language & 6 p^r Handcuffs to be paid for when called on at the price which the Gov^r & Co^l may agree on.
