

Ordered That the collector of the tax for Montgomery County pay to Thomas Richardson five thousand Pounds to be expended in the purchase of Provisions for the Army to be aud^d for.

Tuesday 18th July 1780

Present as on Saturday except Daniel Canoll Esq.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to John King three hundred and Twenty five Pounds balance due him of Account passed by the Depy Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Smith Brooks three hundred Pounds due him of Account passed by the Depy Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Col^o M^orch Forest one thousand and forty one Pounds thirteen shillings and four Pence for 12 Month as aud^d Gen^l ending the 15th Inst.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson jun^r three thousand one hundred and Twenty five Pounds for the use of John Rogers Esq^r Chancellor due him for 3 Months Salary to the first Instant.

That the collector of the tax for Prince Georges County pay to John Smith Brooks five thousand Pounds to be expended in the purchase of Provisions for the Army & accounted for.

That John Giffell deliver to Capt William Reily of the 4th Lieut William Adams of the 7th and Lieut Edward Edgerly of the 2^d Maryland Regimt. each, 6 Gallons of Rum and Twenty four pounds of brown Sugar being the Allowance in those Articles for the Months of May, June and July, and that he furnish the Auditor Gen^l with an Account of the Quantities of the same and those hereafter delivered by him.

That the Commissary of Stores purchase Fresh meat for the Hospital and give it on the order of Col^o Forest.

Charles Blake appointed Commissary of Purchases for Queen Anns County in the room of Conrad T. Wedderhandt who resigned.

Wednesday 19th July 1780

Present as on yesterday

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt William Middleton six hundred and eighty five Pounds, sixteen shillings due him of Acc^t passed by the D. Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Jonathan Parker three hundred and ten Pounds two shillings and also the further Sum of Two hundred and forty three Pounds, ten shillings due him of Accounts passed by the Depy Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut James Bruff of the 6th Regiment Two thousand four hundred Dollars to be expended in the recruiting Service & Aud^d for.

That the said Treasurer pay to Elias Valtelle three hundred and twelve Pounds, ten shillings due him of Acc^t passed by the Aud^d Gen^l.

That Capt George Keppert collect and take into his Possession all the Military Stores & other property belonging to this State at the Fort on Whetstone point in Balt^o Town and dispose of all except the Cannon & Furniture at public vendue after giving Notice in the Balt^o News Paper & in hand Bills and that he render an Account of the Sales to this Board.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Lt W^m Adams of the 7th Regimt Cloak & Jacket for a waistcoat & breeches in part of the Acc^t all^d by Gen^l & Assembly.
