Commission of Letters of Marque & Repisal issued to William Taylor Commander of the Brigantine Duke of Lindsa 100 Stone Gunther, navigated by 60 men mounting 16 Cannage Guns, 2 Swivels and 20 small Arms, belong to Willm. Still of Balt^o.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to a Major Conter & Hanson Esq^r Judge of the General Court three thousand seven hundred and fifty Pounds due him of Account raised by the Aid. Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to John & Anthony six thousand Pounds for the like sum borrowed of him in virtue of a Resolution of the Genl. Assembly of the 7th of a May last, for the purpose of bearing the Expences of the Officers of the Maryland Division on their March to reinforce the Southern Army.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut William Woolford one hundred and ten Pounds due him of Account raised by the Aid. Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to the said Lieut William Woolford Two hundred and eighty three Pounds, five shillings due him of ^{the} Aid. Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to Messrs Gilmour & Russell six thousand six hundred and sixteen Pounds in part of an Order drawn by John Randall State G^othier for Amun purchased of them for the use of the Maryland Officers.

That the Commissary deliver to Lieut William Woolford 14 Gallons of Rum and 50 lb. brown Sugar in full of those Articles of his Allowance for the Months of January, February, March, April, May June & July.

That the Commissary deliver to James Williams 2 pair of Handkerchiefs he gives to be ascertained hereafter.
