the 3<sup>rd</sup> Maryland Regiment and has had the misfortune to lose his Leg one hundred  
and fifty Pounds to enable him to return to his Friends in St. Marys. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Mahoney five hundred and  
five Pounds, five shillings for 15 lb<sup>s</sup> Shoes bought of him & deliv<sup>d</sup> to John & Murr. —
