Ten Shillings and six Pence passed by the Depty Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Col<sup>o</sup> James Todell one hundred and thirty  
one Pounds, fifteen Shillings of the new Emission of this State to be delivered over to  
Russell and Gilmore in lieu of Two thousand Two hundred and seventy Pounds, the  
Balance of J<sup>r</sup> Randall's Order of the 10<sup>th</sup> May last
