That the said Treasurer pay to Capt<sup>t</sup> Michael Boyer fifty Pounds of the new Emission of this State to be delivered over to Capt<sup>t</sup> Geo<sup>r</sup> Keepots on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Athanasius Ford five hundred Pounds of the new Emission of this State to be delivered over to Joseph Ford Esq<sup>r</sup> for St<sup>r</sup> Marys Family on Act.

Capt<sup>t</sup> Michael Boyer of the German Regiment is hereby appointed to issue the Articles allowed to the Officers and Soldiers of the said Regiment agreeably to the Act of Assembly.

This Board have agreed with Matthew Ridley Esq<sup>r</sup> for a ton of white of good Rinn at 27-10-0 of Gall. 2000 Gall. Taffier at 18-15-0 of Gall and 1000 lb of Coffee at £3. 15. 0 to be paid in the new Emission of this State at 1 for 40.

Thursday 21 September 1700

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Brier Esq<sup>r</sup> Twelve Pounds ten shillings of the new Emission of this State on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Muir four hundred Pounds of the new Emission of this State on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to the said John Muir Two hundred and thirty Eight Pounds fifteen shillings being for Shirts & Overalls made for Cont<sup>t</sup> Troops under the Command of Capt<sup>t</sup> William Rely of Act. passed.

Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 1700

Present as on Yesterday.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Giles Two hundred and fifty Pounds of the new Emission of this State to be delivered over to Col<sup>l</sup> Henry Hollingworth on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to His Excell<sup>ty</sup> Thomas Am<sup>l</sup> Lee Esq<sup>r</sup> fifty Two Pounds ten shillings of the new Emission of this State in lieu of an Order of the 25<sup>th</sup> of July for Two thousand five hundred Pounds.

That the Collector of the Tax for Paul County pay to Col<sup>l</sup> Henry Hollingworth Eight thousand Pounds on Account.

That the Commission of Stores deliver to Capt<sup>t</sup> B. Maybury 170 Rations in flour in part due him from the State.
