A Proclamation

Whereas the Senate adjourned to the first Monday in November next & the House of Delegates to the third Monday in Sept^r last past and Subjects of the greatest consequence requiring the immediate Attention and deliberation of the General Assembly; I have therefore thought it expedient that the General Assembly of this State should meet on Tuesday the seventeenth day of October Instant and do therefore in Virtue of the Power with which I am invested by the Constitution and Form of Government hereby appoint the said seventeenth Day of the present Month for the Holding the General Assembly of which the several Sheriffs of this State are hereby enjoined to give public and due notice. Given at Annapolis this fifth Day of Oct^r in the Year one thousand seven hundred & Eighty Tho: S. Lee.
