Ordered That the Young Commissary deliver to Lieut. Lawd. Hanson of the Reg^t. 9th the Coffee deficiency of Stows to the 1st. Inst. and also to Capt William Middleton of the State Boat Dolphin 2 Rations of Day for himself and one Ration of Day for each of the Hands employed to navigate the said Boat.

That the Commissary of Stows deliver to Capt William Deatty 14 Coats, 36 Jackets 17th Breaches, 10 p^{rs} Coveralls, 12 Shirts 85 p^{rs} Stockings, 15 p^{rs} Shoes, 15 hats, 85 Blankets, to be delivered over to the Soldiers in the Maryland Line and to be by him accounted for to the said Com^{rs}.

That the Armourer deliver to Capt Benjamin Williams 45 Muskets complete with Accoutrements 12 Boarding Pikes & 6 Cutlasses to be delivered over to Richard Barnes Esq. Lieut of St. Marys County.

Commission issued to Benjamin Williams appointed Captain of the Barge called the Independence.

The Council have this Day agreed with Capt William Middleton to command the State Boat Dolphin for six Months on the following Terms To have money at the Exchange, 2 Gallons Rum, 12 lb Cocoa Tea, 8 lb Bro. Sugar and 4 1/2 lb Coffee of month and 2 Rations of Day.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer deliver to John Downey Esq. 94 lbs Tobacco weighing 88,997th a 50.2 p^{rs} and 4 p^{rs} amounting to forty six thousand, two hundred and seventy eight p^{rs}, ten shillings, which this Board have sold them.

That John Bullen Esq. Quarter Master deliver to Lt. Alexander Lawson Smith of the Regim^t. 1 Covered Ammunition Wagon, to be charged to the Account.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to John Garreghin a Recruit enlisted for the 8th Regim^t. fourteen Pounds, one shilling and three pence of the new Emission in lieu of one thousand five hundred Dollars part of the Bounty engaged to be given him by Richard Dallam Lieut of Stanford County as appears by his Letter to this Board of the 15th Inst to be charged to the said Richard Dallam.

That the said Treasurer pay to Monica Clifford eight Pounds, three shillings and one penny half penny of the new Emission in lieu of three hundred and Twenty six Pounds five shillings due of her by the Des^y. Aid.

Ordered That the Armourer deliver to Capt William Middleton, what Barkin, Tar and Rigging he may want from time to time for the use of the Dolphin.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to J. Long on one thousand three hundred and ninety six Pounds to be delivered over to Rob^t. J. Hooe due him of the 22nd.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lemetta May five Dollars of the new Emission in lieu of seventy six Pounds due her of the 22nd of the 22nd.

Wednesday 18th October 1780

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to John Fuiall, seven hundred and sixty nine Pounds, ten shillings on Account.
