That the aforesaid Commissary deliver to Capt. Gilbert Middleton 2 rations of Day and 1 for each of his Men and also 2 Gallons Rum and 1/2 lb. Coffee his allowance to the 21st Nov.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Col. Moses Rawlings Commissary for Washington County Two hundred and fifty Pounds of the new Emission on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut. Plant Thirty Pounds of the new Emission to be delivered over to Capt. George P. Keppels on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Doct. James Murray one hundred Pounds of the new Emission on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to His Excellency Thomas Sim Lee Esq. one hundred and fifty Pounds of the new Emission on Account.
