Monday 30 October 1780

Present as on Saturday.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Roger Dowling a soldier in the 6th Maryland Regim^t Ten shillings of the new Emission in lieu of Twenty Pounds allowed him by the Act relating to the Officers and Soldiers &c instead of the Articles therein mentioned.

That the said Treasurer pay to Edward Ovinge four Pounds, two shillings & six Pence of the new Emission in lieu of seventy five Pounds & ninety Pounds due him &c^t passed by the Depy Aud^r.

That the said Treasurer pay to Jonathan Parker an Express engaged agreeable to the Resolution of Congress one hundred and fifty Dollars on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Gilbert Middleton Two Pounds, six shillings & four pence half penny of the new Emission in lieu of ninety Pounds fifteen shillings due him &c^t passed by the Depy Aud^r.

That the said Treasurer deliver to Charles Williamson Esq^r 7 Hhd^s of Tobacco to be delivered over to Thomas Jones Contractor for Horses in Calvert County on Account.

That the said Treasurer deliver to James Calhoun Esq^r Commissary for Baltimore County 100 Hhd^s of Tobacco on Account.

That the Spring Commissary deliver to Capt Gilbert Middleton of the Plator 772 Gall^s of Rum the allowance to the Hands of said Boat.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt Gilbert Middleton 2^{to} Marine and 2^{to} 2 Shirts, 11^{to} Upper & 1^{to} under Jacket, 2^{to} Stockings, 1^{to} Shoes and 1^{to} Breeches for a Negro Michael belonging to the State.

That a Mr John Shaw Armourer deliver to Capt Gilbert Middleton of the Plator 5 lb^s Cannon & 5 lb^s Musket Powder, 3 lb^s Match rope, 10 lb^s Musket Ball, 1^{to} Powder Horn & 1^{to} Powder, 1^{to} Quill Cartridge Paper 50 yms^l & 6^{to} Handkerchiefs.

Tuesday 31. October 1780

Present as on Yesterday.

Ordered That Clement Driscoll one of the Collectors of the Tax for St Marys County pay to Joseph Ford Commissary for said County one thousand nine hundred and seventy six Pounds on A/c^t.

That Richard Clark one of the Collectors for said County pay to the said Joseph Ford Two thousand Pounds to be by him accounted for.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Simon Nicholls Three hundred Pounds of the new Emission to be delivered over to Thomas Richardson Commissary of Montgomery County on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Henry Baldwin, seven Pounds, nineteen shillings and six Pence of the new Emission in lieu of three hundred & nineteen Pounds due him &c^t pass^d by the A^d Gen^l.

That the said Treasurer pay to Francis Fairbrother seven Pounds, four shillings of the new Emission in lieu of Two hundred & eighty eight Pounds due him &c^t pass^d by the Aud^r Gen^l.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt John Hamilton Two Pounds, twelve shillings and six Pence of the new Emission in lieu of one hundred & six Pounds, Two shillings & six Pence due him &c^t pass^d by the Depy Aud^r.
