

Monday 25 June 1701.

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to General Smallwood one yard of Yimmal. Col: Adams six yards flannel and also to Capt James Hamilton of the 4th Regim^t Linen for two shirts and Cloth for a waistcoat and breeches to complete the present year. —

That the Shipping Commissary deliver to Capt Thomas Gifford five Days Provisions and three Gallons of Rum for the crew of the Barge Revenge. —

Tuesday 26th June 1701.

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer deliver to John & Murr Esqrs one hundred Lbs of Tobacco to be delivered over to Col: Samuel Smith to be by him expended in the purchase of Cloathing for the Army on Account.

Wednesday 27 June 1701.

Ordered that the Armorer deliver to Col: Joseph Dastrell Twenty five pounds of Lead and Shot for the use of Worcester County Militia.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Doct: Samuel Glagett one Suit of Cloaths and four shirts for the year 1700. —

Whereas the Board have good reason to believe that Samuel Tomlin's Peconoke found, Thomas Evans, Ship Carpenter lives at Tomlins, William Johnson Indian Aming, William Whiteman partner to Johnson, James Denison of Worcester or Virginia. — Old Crockett Lower Tangier Island, Elijah Arquis, Jacob Haywood Worcester Quaker, John Traverser Snow Hill, Samuel Thomas Ship Carpenter Snow Hill, Robert Pitts, Pitts landing, Robert Parker on Watts Island, Stephen Myster, Samuel Buntingham and John Merchant Shell Town Somerset, have been trading with the Enemy and that they are disaffected and dangerous Persons whose going at large may be prejudicial to the State. The Lieutenants of Somerset and Worcester Counties are therefore ordered to arrest the persons above mentioned without delay and have them before the Board forthwith that they may be dealt with according to Law. —

Thursday 28th June 1701.

Ordered that the Collector of the Tax for Prince Georges County pay to Thomas Glagett and Company, twenty thousand pounds of Tobacco including some plant for the Casks, for one hundred yards Bare skin purchased of them for the Army. —

That the western Shore Treasurer deliver to Frederick Guen the Arms of the State and the plates on which the last Emission was struck. —

Commissions issued to Alpha Rogers appointed 1st Lieut, James Bage 2^o Lieut Richard Odham Ensign of Captains John Oglesby's Company and also to Thomas Littleton John Capstan in the room of Abraham Lazus, Harman Arrents 1st Lieutenant and Nathan Phillips Ensign, belonging to the Elk Battalion of Militia Carl County. —

Friday 29th June 1701.

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to Captain John Courts Jones of the 7th Regiment Trappings for a boat he paying for the same and also to Lieut James Wincheste of the 2^o Regim^t a suit of Cloaths & two shirts for the present year.

Saturday 30 June 1701.

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer deliver to John & Murr Esqrs fifty Lbs of Tobacco to be delivered over to Col: Samuel Smith to be by him expended in procuring Cloathing and accounted for. —
