Ordered that the Young Commissary deliver to Captain Nathaniel M<sup>rs</sup>  
-land one Gallon of Rum. -

Commissions of Letters of Marque and Reprieve issued to Claude Ouse  
Commander of the Schooner Good Adventure fifty six Tons burthen, navigated by six men  
mounting five shewel Guns - Joseph Sudet Commander of the Schooner Resource, fifty  
six Tons burthen, navigated by sixty men, mounting fourteen carriage Guns belonging to  
John Dumost of Baltimore - Peter Melhant Commander of the Schooner Maria  
fifty one Tons burthen, navigated by twelve men mounting five carriage Guns, belonging  
to James Durand & Company of Fredericksburg in Virginia - James Handy Commander  
of the Schooner Dragon, ninety five Tons burthen, navigated by twenty five men  
mounting six carriage Guns belonging to Hugh Young and Company of Baltimore and  
also John Thomas & Boucher Commander of the Brig Alexandria, navigated by forty  
men, mounting twelve carriage Guns belonging to John M<sup>rs</sup> of Baltimore and  
Robert P. Hooe & Thow of Alexandria. -

Monday 9<sup>th</sup> July 1701

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to Jos<sup>ph</sup> Adams as much  
Russia Sheetting or Top Gallant Duck as will finish his Marque to be charged to the  
That the western Shore Treasures deliver to John M<sup>rs</sup> one hundred  
Hides of Tobacco to be delivered over to Jos<sup>ph</sup> Samuel Smith to be by him expended in  
the purchase of Cloathing &c and accounted for. -

In virtue of the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding  
two hundred thousand pounds, on the security of Double the value in Lands, to defray the  
"Expenses of the present Campaign" Thomas Galloway, Thomas Johnson Junr, Frederick  
Green, Isaac M<sup>rs</sup> Hard, Nicholas Harwood and John Callahan are appointed Signers  
of the Bills emitted under the said Act. -

Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> July 1701.

Ordered that the Young Commissary deliver to Capt Robert Chesley of  
the 4<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup>, twelve Gallons of Rum and forty eight pounds of Sugar Stars due  
to the said Instant. -

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to John Baker a Discharged  
Soldier one Shirt, one pair Overall and one Hunting Shirt

Special Commissions of Oyer and Terminer and Goal Delivery issued  
to Dorchester County directed to Nicholas Thomas, William Emmels, John Dutton  
James Murray and Robert Hanifon Esquires or any three or more of them In virtue  
of the Act entitled an Act to enable the Governor to issue Commissions of Oyer and  
Goal Delivery in certain Cases. -

Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> July 1701.

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to Lieut Isaac Rawlings  
Lieut William Murdock, Lieut John Boone, and Capt Archibald McCallister, each,  
Linen for two Shirts for the present Year. - and also to Captain John Mitchell  
two and a quarter yards Russia Duck to be charged to him. -

That the western Shore Treasury pay to James Williams four  
hundred and eighty two pounds, eleven shillings and two pence p<sup>er</sup> annu<sup>m</sup> agreeable to  
the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" due him & Account p<sup>er</sup> paid by the  
Secy Auditor. -
