That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Clement Sherrott of the Artillery eight pounds, fifteen shillings of the same Emission in lieu of Clothing per Account passed by the Aud Genl. -

That the said Treasurer pay to William Drew three pounds and three pence of the same Emission due him as an Express of Accounts passed by the D. Aud. -
