That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Daniel Wells one hundred and fifty one pounds, one Shilling and one penny specie agreeable to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" due him by Account settled by the aud. Gen^l the 12th Inst. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Singleton ten pounds, two Shillings and six pence of the same Emission in lieu of an Order of the 31st May 1781 in his favor for forty pounds, ten Shillings. -
