

Ordered that the western Shore Treasurer pay to Capt Jonathan & Harris Twenty  
two pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding  
two hundred thousand pounds &c. in lieu of Twenty five pounds & give part of the money to be  
issued to the Officers of the Maryland and as soon as money comes into the Treasury after  
the four thousand pounds appropriated for the non Commissioned Officers marching to the  
Southward and the Officers there and those who are going to serve the present Campaign received

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Edmund Compton of the 4<sup>th</sup> Regiment  
ten pounds of the same Emission part of the money appropriated for the Officers going to the Southward.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Nicholas Langens of the 4<sup>th</sup>  
Regiment seven pounds ten shillings of the same Emission part of the money aforesaid.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Harrison one hundred and seven  
pounds & give agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debt due from this State due him  
per Account settled by the Aud. Gen. the 11<sup>th</sup> Inst.

That the Young Commissary deliver to Lieut Henry Clements of the 5<sup>th</sup>  
Regiment eight Gallons of Rum and thirty two pounds of Sugar due him to the 1<sup>st</sup> Inst. —

two pounds fourteen shillings and nine pence half penny of the Bills emitted under

That the said Treasurer pay to Cornelius & Wells Twenty eight pounds  
three shillings and three pence of the same Emission due Allowance on the Journal of  
May Session 1701. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Henry Clements of the 5<sup>th</sup> Regt.  
Ten pounds of the same Emission part of the money appropriated for the Officers  
going to the Southward. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt John Gault Jones of the 4<sup>th</sup> Regt.  
Lieut Christopher Richmond of the 2<sup>d</sup> Regmt Major William Goddard, Capt Richard Waters  
Capt John Gordon, Lieut Isaac Rawlings and Lieut John Shever, each, Twenty pounds  
of the same Emission part of the money appropriated for the Officers going to the Southward

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Alexander Trueman fifteen  
pounds of the same Emission part of the money appropriated as aforesaid. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Thomas Coups Thirty  
pounds of the same Emission part of the money appropriated as aforesaid and also the  
further sum of six pounds eighteen shillings of the same Emission in lieu of Clothing  
per Account passed by the Aud. Gen. —

That the said Treasurer pay to William Tuck thirty three pounds twelve  
shillings of the same Emission part of the three thousand pounds appropriated for the payment  
of Expenses due his Allowance on the Journal of May Session 1701.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Shaw one hundred and twenty  
five pounds, seventeen shillings and seven pence half penny of the same Emission part  
of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him per Ac<sup>t</sup> passed by the Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Brewer nine pounds  
eight shillings and six pence of the same Emission part of the money approp<sup>d</sup> as aforesaid  
due him on the Journal of May Session 1701. —
