specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts from this State per account  
passed by the Aud. Genl. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt John Pitt, fifty five  
pounds, fifteen shillings and six pence and seven pounds ten shillings specie  
agreeable to the above mentioned Act per accounts passed by the Aud. Genl.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Elyah Deane late  
of the 5<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> one Coat, one Shirt, one pair Overalls, one pair of Shoes and  
one Hat, - Lieut Christopher Richmond of the 2<sup>d</sup> Reg<sup>t</sup> Linnen for two Shirts and  
Farming for a Coat, - Major Alexander Rogbough one Suit of Cloaths in ad-  
-vance and two Shirts due him for the present year. Capt Alexander Trueman,  
Lieut John Sears of the 5<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup>, & Lieut Henry Baldwin of the 3<sup>d</sup> Regiment:  
Linnen for two Shirts due them for the present year. Lieut John Chew Cloth and Linnen  
to face a Regim<sup>t</sup> Coat - Capt Richard Waters one Coat and two Shirts and also  
to Lieut Mark McPherson of 2<sup>d</sup> Reg<sup>t</sup> Cloth & Linnen for a Suit of Cloaths &  
Linnen for four Shirts for the present year. -

That the said Commissary deliver to Lieut. John Boone and  
Thomas Rouse each, four Gallons of Rum & fifteen pounds of Sugar and also to  
Lieut John Sears six Gallons of Rum & twenty four pounds of Sugar due to the 1<sup>st</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup>.
