That the said Treasurer pay to Jonathan Slater two hundred and fifteen pounds five shillings specie agreeably to the Act aforesaid due him per Certificates filled by the said Genl. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Col<sup>o</sup> John Dorey eighty nine pounds seven shillings and six pence specie agreeably to the Act aforesaid per Account passed by the said Genl. -

That the said Treasurer pay to General Smallwood nine hundred and eighty eight pounds specie in part of the four thousand pounds, to be distributed to the Officers and Soldiers ordered to the Southward agreeably to the Act relating to Public Creditors -

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Winchester and Capt Thomas O'Hagan, each, fifteen pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding two hundred thousand pounds &c part of the money appropriated to the Officers going to the Southward. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt David Lynn of the 4<sup>th</sup> and Capt Robert Denny of the 5<sup>th</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup>, each, twenty pounds of the same Emission, part of the money appropriated as aforesaid. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Bullon Esquire fifty pounds of the same Emission, to be expended in the purchase of necessaries for General Smallwood's Table and also the further sum of ten pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the present Campaign on Account. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Nicholas Maubbin Gent<sup>l</sup> thirty three pounds seven shillings of the same Emission appropriated as aforesaid. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Johnson three pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the payment of Expenses due him per Account passed by the said Genl. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Wilmoth two pounds seven shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid on Ac<sup>t</sup>. -

That the said Treasurer pay to William Homer six pounds fifteen shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him per Account passed by the said Genl. -

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Lieut Winchester and also to Capt Robert Denny, each, two Shirts - Lieut Reginal Hilliard of the 3<sup>d</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> one Suit of Cloaths and Linen for four Shirts due him for the year 1700 - Major Benjamin Brookes Linen for four Shirts due him for the present year and also to Butler a Soldier in the 3<sup>d</sup> Regiment one Hat, two Shirts one Coat one Vest, one pair of Breeches and one pair of Shoes. -

It appears by an Account passed by the Auditor Genl. of this Day that there is due and owing to John Dorey and Company one thousand seven hundred and thirty seven pounds, seventeen shillings and ten pence specie to be paid to them or their Assignees according to the Act of Assembly entitled "An Act relating to Public Creditors." -
