Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Capt John A Hamilton seven pounds, three shillings of the Bills emitted under the Act for the emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding two hundred thousand pounds &c of the money appropriated for the present Campaign due him per account passed by the Aud^r Gen^l - and also the further sum of fifteen pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated to the Officers going to the Southwards. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Chalmer six pounds seven shillings and six pence and also four pounds eight shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the present Campaign due him per accounts passed by the Aud^r Gen^l and Deput^y Aud^r. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Major Thomas Lawdale Ten pounds two shillings and ten pence of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him per account passed by the Aud^r Gen^l. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Philip Sheppard four pounds, thirteen shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him for riding Expenses per account passed by the Aud^r Gen^l. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Whibell eleven pounds and nine pence of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due himself and others per account passed by the Deput^y Aud^r. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut John Bacon of the 3^d Regt. Twenty pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated to the Officers going to the Southwards. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Joshua Dorey, four pounds eighteen shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the payment of Expenses due his Allowance on the Journal of Accounts for May Septem^r 1701.

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Middleton eighteen pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid for the use of Captain William Middleton on account.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Dorey and Company three hundred and eighty eight pounds, ten shillings and nine pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Act passed by the Asse^m.

That the said Treasurer pay to Jeremiah Townly (Chaud Esq) four hundred and twenty six pounds, nine shillings and eight pence three farthings specie agreeable to the Act aforesaid due him per account passed by the Deput^y Aud^r the 17th July 1701. -

That the said Treasurer pay to George Salmon three hundred and sixty pounds, ten shillings and three pence specie agreeable to the Act aforesaid per account passed by the Aud^r Gen^l. -

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt Richard Dorey of the Artillery two shirts and also to Capt John Jordan of the 2^d Regiment due for the present year. -

That James Calhoun deliver to Mr. Westneys ten barrels of seconds or such stow as will not bear inspection to be delivered to Steg Stewart on out of the Gally building for the State.

That the Printing Com^{rs} deliver to Joseph Middleton twenty four pounds specie for the use of Capt W^m Middleton on account. -
