

Saturday 21 July 1781.

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to Lieut James John  
Kinner of the 1<sup>st</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> and Lem Denwood Surgeon of the 3<sup>d</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup>, each, Linen for  
two Shirts and also to Major John Eccleston one Suit of Cloaths and four Shirts  
due for the present year —

That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Lieut John Boone of the  
3<sup>d</sup> Regim<sup>t</sup> four pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills  
of Credit not exceeding two hundred thousand pounds due of the money appropriated  
for the Officers going to the Southward. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt<sup>l</sup> Lloyd Beall & Edward  
Spurrier, Lieut<sup>l</sup> James Arthur & William Murdoch and Doct<sup>r</sup> Lem Denwood  
each, twenty pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Isaac Rawlings Ten  
pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt James Somerville, seven  
pounds nine shillings and seven pence of the same Emission of the money  
appropriated for the present Campaign due him per Acct<sup>t</sup> passed by the A G<sup>l</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Elijah Evans of Rawlings's  
late Regiment, seven pounds eighteen shillings and one penny half penny of the  
same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him for Stores per  
Account passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to John Welch twelve pounds  
two shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the payment of  
Expenses due due him per Account passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup> and also the  
further sum of two pounds fifteen shillings and two pence of the same Emission  
of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him in lieu of an Order of the 24<sup>th</sup> of  
May last settled by the said Gen<sup>l</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to William Logan three pounds  
eleven shillings and three pence specie agreeably to the Act to "adjust the Debt  
due from this State" due him per Account passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup>. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas White twenty five  
pounds eleven shillings and six pence specie agreeable to the Act aforesaid per  
Account passed by the said Gen<sup>l</sup>. —

That the Young Commissary deliver to Lieut Elijah  
Evans thirty one Gallons of Rum and one hundred and twenty four pounds  
of sugar due him to the 15<sup>th</sup> of April 1781. —

Ordered That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Major  
Eccleston and Capt Gale, each, thirty pounds of the Bills emitted under the  
Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding two hundred thousand pounds  
due of the money appropriated for the Officers going to the Southward. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Brigadier Gen<sup>l</sup> Gist thirty  
pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the present Campaign  
in virtue of a Resolution of this Board of this Day and to be by him  
accounted for. —
