That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Benjamin Price three pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him for Stores to the 1<sup>st</sup> Inst. per Account passed by the Depy Aud. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut James Winchester four pounds, ten shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him for Stores per Account passed by the Depy Aud. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut William Churchock Ten pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid agreeable to a Resolution of this Board of the 22<sup>d</sup> Instant to be accounted for. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Joseph Ford Commissary for St. Marys County twenty pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid on Account and also the further Sum of Twenty two pounds, five shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him in part of an Account passed by the Depy Aud. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt James Somerville Ten pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the Officers going to the Southward.

That the said Treasurer pay to Henry May four pounds, ten shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the Defense of the State due him per Account passed by the Depy Aud. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Richard Dorsey of the Maryland Artillery Thirty pounds of the same Emission in lieu of Thirty pounds Specie allowed the Officers of the Maryland Line by an Act of the Genl Assembly. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Colen Luyon Esq one hundred and ninety pounds, nine shillings and nine pence Specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State due him per Account passed by the Aud Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Thompson eighteen pounds four shillings Specie agreeable to the above mentioned Act, & paid by the Aud. Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Joseph Ford seventy six pounds, eleven shillings and five pence Specie agreeable to the aforesaid Act due him in part of an Account passed by the Depy Aud. -

That the said Treasurer pay to the said Joseph Ford four thousand one hundred and seventy eight pounds of Tobacco due him per Aud. passed by the D. Aud.

That the Spring Commissary deliver to Capt William Reily, Esq. Mark McPherson, Lieut James Arthur, each, four gallons of Rum and fifteen pounds of Sugar. Lieut Philip Hill & James Winchester, each, twelve gallons of Rum and forty eight pounds of Sugar and also to Capt Benjamin Price eight gallons of Rum and thirty two pounds of Sugar due to the 1<sup>st</sup> Instant. -

That the Armorer deliver to Stephen Steward thirty musket Balls two quire cartridge paper and twelve flints. -
