That the said Treasurer pay to Charles Sandale forty pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid to be delivered over to John Smith Brookes Commissary of Anna Georges County on Account. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Clement Skerick of the Maryland Artillery Thirty pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid on Account and also five pounds, two shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him in lieu of Allow per Account passed by the Aud: Gen: -

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Robinson, two pounds & eight pence Specie agreeable to the Act to Adjust the Debt due from this State per Act: passed by the Aud: Gen: the 1st of June 1781.
