pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the present Campaign
to be by him expended in necessaries for the Hospital in Baltimore Town on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Richard Waters of the 3^d Regim^t
Twelve pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him for
Stores per Account passed by the Aud. Gen. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Major John Davidson fourteen pounds
twelve shillings and six pence of the same Emission of the money appropriated as
aforesaid due him per Account passed by the Depy Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Thomas Mason five pounds
five shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him
for Stores to the 31st Inst. & Act passed by the Depy Aud. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Edward Hall fourteen pounds
five shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due
him for Stores per Account passed by the Depy Aud. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Thomas Jones seventeen pounds
ten shillings of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him per Account
passed by the Aud. Gen. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Doct. Charles Frederick Wierenthal
one thousand five hundred and forty three pounds, six shillings and nine pence specie
