Ordered that the Warring Commissary deliver to Capt Richard Waters of the 3^d Regim^t thirty two Gallons of Rum and one hundred and twenty eight pounds of Sugar - Capt Thomas Mason four Gallons of Rum and fifteen pounds of Sugar - Capt Edward Clark of the 1st Regim^t ten Gallons of Rum and forty pounds of Sugar - and also to Lt^o Thomas Jones two days rations for himself and 18 hands employed in bringing Recruits from Dorchester County. -

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt John Spragg Belt of the 1st Regim^t forage for a year. -

That the Armorer deliver to Lt^o Jones one hundred Musket Cartridges for the use of the Dorchester Militias. -

Commission issued to John Stevens appointed Sheriff of Dorchester County in the room of James Woolford resigned. -

Sunday 29th July 1701.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Mark Alexander Esq^r Three hundred and forty Dollars of the Bills emitted under the "Act for the Emission of Bills of credit, not exceeding two hundred thousand pounds Year" of the money appropriated for the present Campaign to be delivered over to Philip Welsh Ludwik Lawman, James McGarty, Isaac Lewis, William Clark, Nath^l McKnight John Gollheid, Timothy Durn, Gernont Richards, Samuel Chalodge, John Gile, Mith^l Kenwy, Valentine Lynn, Thomas Kelly, Daniel Murphy, Thomas Grant and William Welsh Recruits from Baltimore County each, twenty Dollars the Bounty allowed by the "Act to raise two Battalions of Militias Year" and also the further Sum of eighty eight Dollars for recruiting them. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Robert Derry Two thousand two hundred and fifty pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid to be by him applied to the enlisting the men engaged to serve until the 10th day of Decem^r next or other for three years or during the war on Account. -

Monday 30th July 1701.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to John Brice Esquire seven pounds, eleven shillings and four pence of the Bills emitted under the "Act for the Emission of Bills of credit, not exceeding two hundred thousand pounds Year" of the money appropriated for the present Campaign due him per Account, paid by the Aud^r Gen^l. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Roger Nelson of the 5th Regim^t thirty pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid on Account and also the further Sum of five pounds five shillings of the same Emission due him for Stores per Account paid by the Depty Aud^r.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Isaac Hanson of the 1st Regim^t thirty pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid on Account and also the further Sum of Eleven pounds, five shillings of the same Emission due him for Stores per Account paid by the Depty Aud^r.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Alexander Trueman one pound, ten shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him for Stores per Account paid by the Depty Aud^r. -
