

Ordered that the western shew Treasurer pay to David Rice Deput¹¹⁹ Master one hundred and fifty pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding two hundred thousand pounds of the money appropriated for the present Campaign part thereof to be expended in purchasing fifty common Tents, five Hasemani Tents and one hundred Camp Kettles. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Gilbert Middleton one hundred and nine pounds, fifteen Shillings and five pence of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the Defense of the State due him per Account passed by the Aid. Genl. —

That the Spring Commissary deliver to Capt John Smith Thirty two Gallons of Rum and one hundred and twenty eight pounds of Sugar. Lieut. Arthur Harris Thirty two Gallons of Rum and one hundred and four pounds of Sugar. Capt Philip Reed Thirty Gallons of Rum and one hundred and four pounds of Sugar. Capt John Lynch Thirty Gallons of Rum and ninety six pounds of Sugar. Capt Jacob Dries Thirty Gallons of Rum and one hundred and twenty pounds of Sugar. Doct. Levin Denwood eight Gallons of Rum and thirty two pounds of Sugar. Lieut William Adams sixteen Gallons and an half a Gallon of Rum and fifty eight pounds of Sugar. Lieut Jacob Norris Thirty four Gallons Rum and one hundred and twenty pounds of Sugar, and also to Capt William Dent Beall four Gallons of Rum and fifteen pounds of Sugar due to this instant. —

Ordered that the western shew Treasurer pay to Capt Silburn Williams of the 3rd Regim^t Thirty one pounds, one Shilling of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding two hundred thousand pounds of the money appropriated for the present Campaign in lieu of Clothing on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Alexander Trueman four pounds seven Shillings and six pence of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid in lieu of Clothing on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut. Robert Denny one hundred and twenty Dollars of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid to be delivered over to the following Officers, Capt Lieut Wilson of the South Carolina Artillery, Capt Lowan, Mr. Matthew Depp Master of the Master, Lieut Jordan and David Rice Deput Judge Advocate all of the Georgia Line and Daniel Rice Lieut of the Navy of Pennsylvania, to Lieut Colo. Vaughan and Major Patten of the Delaware Line, each fifteen Dollars and Lieut Duff and Mr. Williams of said Line each ten Dollars to be charged to the Account and by the said Denny accounted for.

That the said Treasurer pay to the said Lieut Robert Denny one hundred and fifty pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid, to be by him delivered over to the Soldiers of the Maryland Line in this City returned from Captivity in South Carolina in a Distressed Situation each, five pounds to be by the said Denny accounted for.

That the said Treasurer pay to the said Lieut Robert Denny three pounds, fifteen Shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid for Shoes on Account.

That the Spring Commissary deliver to the said Lieut Robert Denny four Gallons Rum & fifteen pounds of Sugar to 1st Inst. —
