That the western Shore Treasurer pay to Gerard Wood app^d Surgeons & Mate Samuel B. Beall, appointed Ensign, each, Ten pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding two hundred thousand pounds &c of the money appropriated for the present Campaign on Account.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Gerard Wood and Samuel B. Beall, each one suit of Cloaths & Linen for two Shirts on Account.
