Smith Brooks Commissary of Prince Georges County and the other forty pounds  
to Hezekiah Radu Commissary of Charles County to be by them Accounted for -  
and also six pounds, nineteen shillings and six pence of the same Emission of the  
money appropriated for the Defense of the State due said Wilmet & paid by the 11
