Present as on Yesterday

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to David Kerr five Dollars for the transportation of five Continental Soldiers from Baltimore per Account passed. -

Friday January 31st 1783.

Present as on Yesterday. -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Jonathan Hudson Esquire one hundred and sixteen pounds six shillings and eight pence specie out of the money appropriated for the Payment of Creditors of a particular description for Money lent May 1780 per Act passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to the said Jonathan Hudson two hundred and thirty nine pounds five shillings and eleven pence specie out of the money aforesaid part of an Account passed 29th Inst. -

That the said Treasurer pay to the said Jonathan Hudson two hundred and thirty nine pounds five shillings and eleven pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State's Balance of an Account passed the 29th instant.

Saturday February 1st 1783.

Present Benjamin Stoddert and G Duwall Esquires. -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Zeph^o Turner Esquire one hundred pounds specie for one Quarter's Salary as Auditor General ending 31 January. -

His Excellency the Governor - James Brice and John H Stone Esquires attended. -

Daniel of St Thomas Senifer Esquire appeared before the Board in compliance with the Act of Assembly appointing him Intendant of the Revenue and all public Monies and executed a Bond in the Penalty of Twenty thousand pounds with Robert Loudon and John H Stone Securities agreeable to the said Act, and also took the Oath prescribed therein. -

Monday February 3rd 1783

Present His Excellency the Governor and all Members.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Dove Ten pounds five shillings and six pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Account passed October 10th 1783. -

That the Intendant be requested to deliver to Jeremiah T Chas Esq three hundred and thirty three Bushels and one third of a Bushel of Wheat in Baltimore Town or the Head of Elk on Account of his last Year's Salary. -
