Ordered that a Lt. Shaw deliver to Sergeant Smit for the Guides at West River seven Muskets with Bayonets, seven Curbuck Boxes with six rounds of Cartridges to each, to be returned when called for -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to John Dyer two pounds twelve shillings and six pence specie out of the five shillings specie Tax for Forage supplied Capt John Middleton for Continental Horses procured under the Act to furnish twenty Dragoon Horses for the Southern Army on Account of the United States per Account passed -

That the said Treasurer pay to James Miller thirteen Pounds five shillings and seven pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Account passed -

Commissions issued to Zachariah Allen appointed Notary Public of Baltimore County -

Matthew Dwyer, Charles Daffin, Philemon Downs & Gebdul Potter, and William Frazier appointed Justices of the Orphans Court of Caroline County - and also to Ignatius Taylor, Hanson Briscoe John Shanks, John Ireland and Ignatius Fenwick Justices of the Orphans Court of Saint Marys County -

Saturday 1st March 1703

Present Benjamin Stoddert, Gabriel Duwall, Jeremiah T. Chase James Bruce and John A Stone Esquires -

Permission given to John Lee Master of the Schooner *Trimior* navigated as expressed in Admiral Digby's Passport to pass from hence to New York, having on board two hundred Bushels of Indian Corn, seven Barrels of Flour, six hogs, salted in a Ashes, and one Barrel nine hundred pounds thirty hams, two Kegs of Hog Fat.

Permission given to James Belt Master of the Schooner *Celerity* fifty Tons burthen, navigated by himself Osbun Belt, Mate and seven Men, being a square Sterned Vessel forty feet a Keel, to pass with the said Vessel under Sanction of a Flag of Truce to Wye River in this State to take in thirteen hundred and fifty bushels of Indian Corn, and to proceed from thence to the City of New York with the said Cargo, for the use of the Maryland Prisoners there and to return again -

The following Accounts examined and approved agreeable to a Supplement to the Act for the liquidation and payment of Debts against Persons convicted of Treason - Frederick Green against

Henry Riddle three pounds, fifteen shillings & six pence - Daniel Stephenson one pound eight shillings - Rob. Christie just one pound thirteen shillings. Saml Dulaney of Walt. four pounds three shillings & six pence - Rob. Alexander five pounds, eight shillings & three pence - Rob. Egan six pounds & six shillings & eight pence. Also Dulaney five pounds & three pence. Let them be paid.
