Saturday 8th March 1783

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson J^r Three hundred and eight pounds, nineteen shillings and one penny out of the money appropriated for the Payment of the Arrears of the Barges and also the further sum of one hundred and twenty pounds out of the money for the new Equipment on Account. -

Permission given to Capt Patten master of the Schooner Polly, thirty Tons burthen, a square Sterned Vessel Ballasted with Iron navigated by himself and six men, to pass with the said Vessel under the Sanction of a Flag of Truce with a Sub Gentleman and his Companion on Board and the necessary Stores and Provisions for the Voyage to the Island of Bermuda, and to return again. -

Monday 10th March 1783

Present as on Saturday. -

Permission given to Walter Row of Baltimore County to solicit Leave of His Excellency General Washington or the Commanding Officer at Dobbs Ferry to go to New York by Dobbs's Ferry, to transact private Business and to return. -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer issue a Certificate agreeable to the "Act proposing to the Citizens of this State Creditors of Congress on Loan Office Certificates due" to Samuel Thomas J^r for sixteen pounds, sixteen shillings and ten pence due on Continental Loan Office Certificates adjusted by the Depty Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Driley eight pounds, five shillings specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debt due per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to John Crisall, nine pounds out of the money app^d for the new Equipment of the Barges to procure Fresh Provisions for the Bargesmen on Account. -
