Present His Excellency the Governor

Benjamin Stoddert, James Bruce and John A. Stone Esquires. -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Michael Ramer Ex^{ts} of John Haas fifty pounds, thirteen shillings and four pence - Andrew Woolf three pounds, fourteen shillings and nine pence - Sarah Madden four pounds, five shillings and nine pence and Philip Barger two pounds eighteen shillings and three pence spec^s agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Certificate & Amounts adjusted & passed. -

That the said Treasurer issue Certificates agreeable to the "Act proposing to the Citizens of this State Creditors of Congress on Loan Office Certificates &c" forty three pounds, three shillings and one penny to Stephen Ransburgh - eleven pounds, four shillings and three pence to Nicholas Toup - Eighty seven pounds, and four pence to William Murdoch Beale Seventeen pounds, seventeen shillings and one penny to Michael Stoker Twenty one pounds, six shillings and seven pence to William Snyder - Ninety three pounds, nine shillings and two pence to Peter Crapell - One Hundred and ten pounds, thirteen shillings to George Curtis - Thirty eight pounds eleven shillings and two pence to William Dern - Thirty five pounds, seven shillings and three pence to Michael Ramer - Six pounds, twelve shillings and six pence to Valentine Rhinheart - Five pounds, nine shillings and five pence to Christopher Edelm - seventeen pounds, thirteen shillings and four pence to George Rhinheart - Sixty pounds, thirteen shillings and six pence to Joseph Beall son of Nimon, - two Hundred and sixty two pounds, fourteen shillings to George Jacob Ashley and sixty nine pounds eighteen shillings and four pence to John Groffe due them on Continental Loan Office Certificates adjusted 13th Instant

The Amount of Christopher Lowender against the Reverend Jonathan Boucher for fourteen pounds, eight shillings and one penny Currency examined and approved agreeable to "a Supplement to the Act for the Liquidation and Payment of Debts against persons convicted of Treason"

Commissions of Letters of Marque and Regival issued to John Channing Master of the Schooner Havana, sixty Tons burthen, navigated by fifteen men, mounting seven Carriage Guns - and also to Hugh Willson Master of the Schooner Greyhound one Hundred Tons burthen, navigated by twenty men, mounting seven Carriage Guns belonging Thomas Worthington & others of Baltimore. -
