

Barrels of Stour the Balances now remaining to be carried of the two hundred and twenty five Barrels mentioned in the Permission and Agreement of the 28th of January last -

Permission given to Walter Belt master of the Schooner *Wlymt* a square Sterned Vessel burthen eighty three Tons navigated by himself his Mate and seven men to pass with the said Vessel under direction of a Pilot of Stour from the Port of Baltimore in the State to Vicoma in Dorchester County there to take in two thousand, six hundred and thirty three Bushels of Indian Corn and to proceed from thence to New York with her said cargo for the use of the Maryland Prisoners there and to return again -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson Jun^r sixteen pounds ten shillings out of the money appropriated for the New Equipment of the Barges on Account

It appearing to this Board that Thomas Wilkes of Fiske County was fined twenty pounds by a Militia Court Martial held at Frederick Town September 21. 1701 for neglecting to March to Georgetown and it being represented by the Certificate of Capt Ralph Alleye Joseph Maddin, Ralph Crab, Thomas Darnall and William A. Hall that the said Thomas Wilkes served five Months in Capt Alleye's Company of Select Militia in Frederick County and his behaviour during that Time was in every point such as became a true and Faithful Soldier and Subject of this State It is therefore Ordered that nineteen Pounds part of the Twenty pounds be remitted unto the said Thomas Wilkes -

Whereas it appears to this Board that John Stouder of Frederick County was fined thirty pounds specie by a Militia Court Martial held at Frederick Town 21 September 1701 for not doing duty as Guard to the British Convention Troops at Frederick Town and it is represented by the Petition of the said John Stouder certified by several of his Neighbours and also the Deposition of John Carter and Thomas Brown that he the said John Stouder was sick when he should be on Duty and continued so the best part of the Summer - It is therefore ordered that Twenty nine pounds, part of the thirty pounds aforesaid be and is hereby remitted -
