Present His Excellency William Pava Esquire Governor.

Benjamin Stoddert and James Bree Esquires

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Eliz^a Maxwell sixteen pounds, fifteen shillings and nine pence, Doct. Richard Tootell Esq^r four pounds, four shillings and nine pence half penny and John Bolton twenty four pounds, seventeen shillings and three pence three farthings specie for one years interest due them on certificates issued agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State. -

Friday 4th April 1703.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to William Baker Twenty pounds eleven shillings - and to John Lacey twenty four pounds, nineteen shillings and five pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Quomts passed. -

That the said Treasurer issue certificates agreeable to the Act proposing to the Citizens of this State, Creditors of Congress on Loan Office certificates due to John Forbes for four hundred and fifty six pounds, sixteen shillings and six pence and to Benedict Edelens for thirty five pounds, fourteen shillings and ten pence due them on Continental Loan Office certificates adjusted by the Aud Gen^l. -

Permission given to Mrs Eleanor Stevens of Worcester County to go into the City of New York by Dobb's Ferry on Private Business, and to return. -

Doct. John Shuttleworth who hath lately arrived in this State from Great Britam, but last from New York, appeared before the Governor and Council and before them did make repeat and subscribe the Declaration of his Belief in the Christian Religion, took repeated and subscribed the Oath of Fidelity and Support to this State prescribed by the "Act to punish certain Crimes and Misdemeanors and to prevent the Growth of Toryism" and also the Oath directed to be taken in the "Act for Naturalization". -
