The Permission given Captain Walter Belt the 15th of March last to proceed with the Schooner Wagnot to the City of New York is returned and Permission given to the said Captain Walter Belt of the said Schooner to pass from the City of Annapolis in the said Vessel to the City of New York with a Cargo of Corn and Flour and thence to bring back into this State any Goods or Effects, subject nevertheless to the Duties payable thereon by Law. Permission is also granted to Mrs. Cusson to come in the said Vessel to the Port of Baltimore and to bring with her any Effects. —

That the said Treasurer issue Certificates agreeable to the "Act proposing to the Citizens of this State, Creditors of Congress on Loan Office Certificates due" to James Brui Esq^r for Ten pounds, eleven shillings and to Ann Brui for eight Pounds, fifteen shillings and ten pence due them on Continental Loan Office Cert^s adjusted by the Act 19th Inst^r Gabriel Duwall Esquire attended.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Allen Luyam Esquire twenty seven pounds and six pence specie due him for Wood purchased per amount passed —
