Ordered that the western shore Treasurer issue Certificates agreeable to the Act proposing to the Citizens of this State, Creditors of Congress on Loan Office Certificates due to George Devilbiss for sixty two pounds eight shillings & to John Kamburgh for sixty four pounds fifteen shillings and six pence due them on Continental Loan Office Certificates adjusted by D. Aud<sup>r</sup> -

That the said Treasurer pay to George Devilbiss nine pounds, ten shillings and six pence for one Years Interest on a Certificate issued agreeable to this Act to adjust the Debts due from this State. -

John H Stone Esquire attended. -

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Howes. Goldsborough Esq<sup>r</sup> nineteen pounds, fourteen shillings and ten pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Act passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Allen Luyum Esquire, four pounds, nineteen shillings and four pence out of the Money set apart for Contingent Expenses per Account passed. -

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Aquatius Fenwick, seventeen thousand, three hundred and fifty pounds of nett Tobacco at George Town and Blantensburgh Warehouses due him for the like Quantity sent the State in Novem<sup>r</sup> 1780 per Certificates adjusted by the Depts Aud<sup>r</sup> -

Office Certificates adjusted by the D. Aud<sup>r</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> Int<sup>r</sup> -

That the said Treasurer pay to Samuel Wilson twenty six pounds, seven shillings and three pence. John Stewart sixty three pounds, two shillings & eight pence. Arnold Elvey twenty pounds, nine shillings & John Bloodworth five pounds, two shillings & six pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debt due per Account passed 1<sup>st</sup> Int<sup>r</sup> -

That the said Treasurer pay to Henry Jackson Esq<sup>r</sup> for the use of Capt Heber Whittingham two pounds, five shillings out of the money set apart for Contingent Expenses per Account passed. -
